





NIBS Report

Molly and I traveled to India in the first week of June. The purpose was to conduct a retreat for pastors and their families to encourage them in ministry and provide a strategy for the response of MBS churches to the threat of persecution from militant Hindu groups.





The Catholic center, where housing and classroom space have been rented in recent years, was unavailable. Due to political restrictions on foreign visitors on many campuses in many states. We could not avail the campus in June. As most of our classes are taught by teachers from the USA, we had to cancel them.

But God provided us with a new campus in the state of Punjab. We were able to conduct fall modules. Dr Dodson and I have taught three modules. We are thankful to God for providing us the campus.

AN INFORMATIONAL UPDATE ON NIBS BUILDING PLAN

As you may recall, fundraising for the North India Baptist Seminary reached the point where a small tract of land was purchased in the month of December 2022. This was in the city of Chandigarh in the state of Punjab. (Punjab is the only state without an anti-conversion law, thus it is considered a safer area for a Christian ministry to be established.) Through additional gifts, the financial goal was reached in April 2023 which would enable NIBS to erect their first building. We were able to secure the necessary building permits and find a contractor. This was done, but the contractor desired to wait until October to begin in order to avoid the rainy season and gave a projected completion date of 18 months from then.

In the meantime, plans were made for the September seminary module. While we were in India we came to know about the campus, which was built in 2016 by the Church of the Nazarene. Molly and I had the privilege to visit the campus even before we had our classes there.

This property in Patiala Punjab (about one and a half hours from Chandigarh) was not only available for the modules but was also for sale. This is a Church of the Nazarene property with a tract of land almost twice the size of the NIBS-owned tract and a building already on it! In addition, there is a congregation of 200+ meeting in the church hall which is attached to the building, and the leaders are willing to turn these believers over to the Maranatha Baptist Society of churches! (Not all of these Nazarenes will likely accept bible doctrine taught by Baptists, but there is a possibility that many will. God can do a work in hearts.)


The Director of the campus told us that they are also willing to sell the campus if we are interested. But we thought before we can take any decision on it we should have our classes and see if that campus will suit us. The September module was held here and housed the 48 students and staff.

After the classes, our leaders sat down and discussed about the possibility of buying the campus for NIBS. They all are in favor of buying it as this would provide us a campus for NIBS. Dr Dodson also sat in our meeting with the director of the campus. After the meeting, I was able to send pictures and information to our pastor here in the US.

I was able to sit down with our Pastor and mission committee members of our Church and share our plan after arriving here in the US. And this week I discussed it with our field director. He has informed me that BMM has given us approval to purchase the campus for NIBS. We are thankful that God has provided us needed amount to make a purchase.

Church planting reports

Recently, we organized a retreat for our pastors and their wives to discuss the political situation in their respective areas. The main aim of this meeting was to provide them with encouragement, and education on legal options and actions in case their local churches are targeted and vandalized. We also emphasized the ethical moral responsibility and of supporting fellow team members and church planters.

All of our Church planters gathered in Chandigarh with their family. There were about 69 people. We praise God for providing a place and finances to hold our first family retreat in June.

We had men who gave us advice on legal issues. I talked about our Ethical and Moral responsibility in times of opposition and persecution. We had two of our church planters attacked and threatened a few months ago. Their gathering places were vandalized. Many of you have prayed and helped. Most of the Northern states have implemented anti-conversion laws. Therefore it is necessary to have such meetings for our church planters.

Please pray for our church planters who are fearlessly spreading the message of the love of Christ and hope in states with anti-conversion laws. Your prayers can provide them
